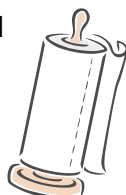

We would like to remind you that we will continue to take nominees for positive performance stories. The next nominees will be announced in the January 2010 issue.

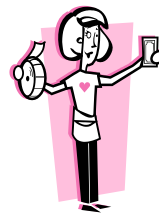

Veteran's Day is **Wednesday, November 11th**. Don't forget to wear your RED, WHITE and BLUE in honor of those who have served to keep our freedom!



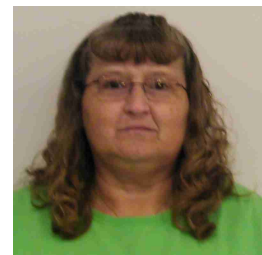

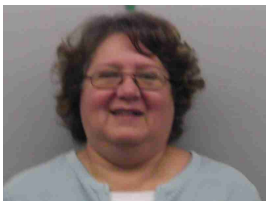

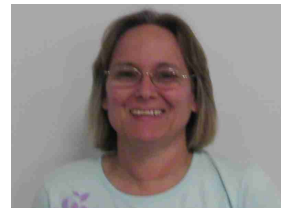
